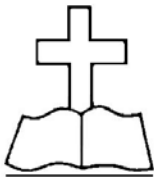
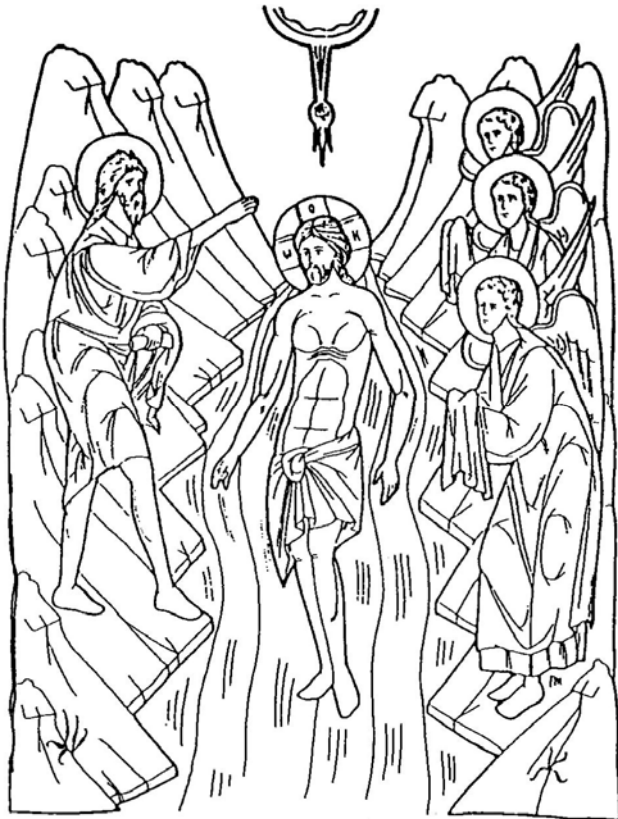


**January 10, 2010**
